

Verses on Forgiveness

Mark 11:25 (New King James Version)

25 "And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses.

Luke 6:37 (New King James Version)

37 "Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

Matthew 18:21-22 (New King James Version)

21 Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?"

22 Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven.

Matthew 18:23-35 (New King James Version)

23 Therefore the kingdom of heaven is like a certain king who wanted to settle accounts with his servants. 24 And when he had begun to settle accounts, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents. 25 But as he was not able to pay, his master commanded that he be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and that payment be made. 26 The servant therefore fell down before him, saying, 'Master, have patience with me, and I will pay you all.' 27 Then the master of that servant was moved with compassion, released him, and forgave him the debt.

28 "But that servant went out and found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii; and he laid hands on him and took *him* by the throat, saying, 'Pay me what you owe!' 29 So his fellow servant fell down at his feet and begged him, saying, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you all.' 30 And he would not, but went and threw him into prison till he should pay the debt. 31 So when his fellow servants saw what had been done, they were very grieved, and came and told their master all that had been done. 32 Then his master, after he had called him, said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you begged me. 33 Should you not also have had compassion on your fellow servant, just as I had pity on you?' 34 And his master was angry, and delivered him to the torturers until he should pay all that was due to him.

35 "So My heavenly Father also will do to you if each of you, from his heart, does not forgive his brother his trespasses."

Psalms 133:1 (New International Version)

1 How good and pleasant it is
when brothers live together in unity!

Matthew 6:14-15 (New King James Version)

14 "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

James 2:13 (New King James Version)

13 For judgment is without mercy to the one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment.

Colossians 3:12-13 (New King James Version)

12 Therefore, as *the* elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*.

Matthew 6:12 (New King James Version)

12 And forgive us our debts,
As we forgive our debtors.

2 Corinthians 10:5 (New King James Version)

5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God,
bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

Philippians 4:8 (New King James Version)

8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things *are* noble, whatever things *are* just,
whatever things *are* pure, whatever things *are* lovely, whatever things *are* of good report, if *there*
is any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.

Ephesians 4:31-32 (New King James Version)

31 Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all
malice. 32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in
Christ forgave you.

Hebrews 12:15 (New King James Version)

15 looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing
up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled;

Colossians 3:13 (New King James Version)

13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against
another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*.
