John 17:17 (New King James Version)

17 Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

Matthew 7:24-27 (New King James Version)

Build on the Rock

24 “Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: 25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.

26 “But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: 27 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall.”

2 Timothy 2:14-15 (New King James Version)

Approved and Disapproved Workers

14 Remind *them* of these things, charging *them* before the Lord not to strive about words to no profit, to the ruin of the hearers. 15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Psalms 141:3 (New King James Version)

3 Set a guard, O LORD, over my mouth;
Keep watch over the door of my lips.

Deuteronomy 32:46-47 (New King James Version)

46 and he said to them: “Set your hearts on all the words which I testify among you today, which you shall command your children to be careful to observe—all the words of this law. 47 For it *is* not a futile thing for you, because it *is* your life, and by this word you shall prolong *your* days in the land which you cross over the Jordan to possess.”

2 Timothy 2:24-25 (New King James Version)

24 And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, 25 in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth,

Galatians 6:9 (New King James Version)

9 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

2 Timothy 3:14-16 (New King James Version)

14 But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned *them*, 15 and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

16 All Scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,

2 Timothy 1:5 (New King James Version)

5 when I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.

John 5:39 (New King James Version)

39 You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.

2 Peter 1:21 (New King James Version)

21 for prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke *as they were* moved by the Holy Spirit.

Psalm 127 (New King James Version)

A Song of Ascents. Of Solomon.

1 Unless the LORD builds the house,
They labor in vain who build it;
Unless the LORD guards the city,
The watchman stays awake in vain.

2 *It is vain* for you to rise up early,
To sit up late,
To eat the bread of sorrows;
For so He gives His beloved sleep.

3 Behold, children *are* a heritage from the LORD,
The fruit of the womb *is* a reward.

4 Like arrows in the hand of a warrior,

Meditate on These Things

Deuteronomy 6:6-7 (New King James Version)

6 "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.
